

CORALMAR

We all agree that holidays at Coralmar are a pleasure and a delight, and to keep it that way everyone should be encouraged to respect the very few rules that make life easier for all of us.

The co-ownership council of the Marina and its President have prepared this summary for you to keep in your apartment for the advice and information of temporary and occasional users.

THE APARTMENT

The apartment block is built in such a way that any noise travels far within the building, especially at night, so please take care to keep unnecessary noise to a minimum:

Be careful when moving luggage or furniture to minimise noise.
Keep conversations to a reasonable level.

The appearance of the building is an important factor to its enjoyment by all, so please:
Do Not Hang any washing or linen on the guard rails or balconies and try to make it invisible.

Do not throw anything from the balconies, either upwards or downwards

Barbecues with open fire are forbidden by law.

Work is forbidden from April 1 to October 15, when it is authorized, please respect weekends and meal times.

CORRIDORS TERRACES & PASSAGEWAYS

These areas must be kept clear and not cluttered with furniture or luggage: Even temporarily. They are public spaces and cannot be “appropriated” for personal use, or used for playing games at any time.

POOLS

Please keep to the published opening hours. Maintenance has to be done daily, in the morning and all the spaces around the pool need to be kept clear for this maintenance to get done properly. In the evening, please leave the pool area.

Deckchairs are for everyone. They cannot be reserved by anyone. Neither should they be removed from their normal place.

If you are listening to music, please use headphones or earphones.

Li-Los, Air mattresses, plastic inflatable animals etc. are not allowed.

Keep Ball Games brief to avoid monopolizing the space and disturbing others.

As far as is possible, parents should keep their children under control and quiet.

For everyone safety, any glass objects are strictly forbidden in the pool area or on the beaches. Eating and drinking are forbidden, as well as organizing an aperitif.

Pets

Pets are not welcome at the pool.

Keep pets under control, clean up their mess and keep them as quiet as possible.

Parking

Parking places are scarce in high season, but it is not an excuse to park inconsiderately.
Long-term parking of unused vehicles is prohibited.

to ensure everyone has a great holiday.
